- Canned or dry pet food.
- Standard-size pillowcases.
- Canned goat's milk or infant kitten or puppy milk replacer formula (available at pet stores or from veterinarians) for nursing kittens and puppies that come to the Center without moms.
- Baby shampoo for bathing puppies and kittens.
- Old kitchen or bath towels.
- Beach towels (good for bedding in dog kennels).
- Used baby blankets. They are the perfect size bedding for lots of the Center's animals.
- Vinyl-covered baby bed "bumper" pads.
- Hard rubber baby teething rings.
- Small, hard rubber toys for dogs.
- Medium-size, WASHABLE stuffed animal toys.
- Recycle! Donate your aluminum beverage cans to the Animal Service Center.
- Volunteer. Volunteering doesn't have to involve a large commitment—the shelter does ask that you work a similar time slot every week. An hour or two on a Saturday afternoon isn't a big chunk out of your week, but it will mean the world to the shelter staff, and the dogs (and cats) you can walk during that time!
